In the 1991 Census the number of women by parity was not published if the number in a given birth cohort and parity category was lower than 4. Therefore, some figures for birth cohorts 1975–1966 and for women at parities 2–6+ are substituted by a dot “.”, which denotes a missing value.

The distribution of women by the number of live-born children was recalculated from the Census date to 1 January of a given year (1991 or 2001), using the exact numbers of live-born children by birth order, age of the mother, and day of birth between 1 January and the Census date.

In year 1957, one birth was moved from age 11 to age 12 (by Lexis vertical parallelograms), in order to make data consistent with those in other data sources (Observatoire démographique européen and Eurostat) and to be consistent with the numbers of births by Lexis squares.

In year 1963, two births were moved from age 12 to age 10 (by Lexis squares), in order to make data consistent those in other data source (Die Natürliche Bevölkerungsbewegung im Jahre 1963, Österreichisches Statistisches Zentralamt, Wien 1964).

For 1951–1983, data by Lexis triangles were estimated by combining data available by Lexis vertical parallelograms (RefCodes 3 and 4) and by Lexis squares (RefCode 5).
