

Country codes used in the HFD are standardized international country codes maintained by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO 3166-1 alpha-3 codes; a freely-accessible list is available at Wikipedia: http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/ISO_3166-1_alpha-3). For subpopulations or areas not corresponding to an ISO country, the ISO 3166-2 region codes (where available) are used as an extension of country code. In cases where such a code is not available, e.g. for Eastern and Western Germany, the code used and its description must be provided in the Background and Documentation file. Country, area, and subpopulation codes used in the HFD are usually identical to codes used in the HMD.
